What is a Remarkable Reader?

- A student who is passionate about reading.
- A student who reads way beyond what is required.
- A student who has read every Warriors novel or every Horowitz thriller.
- A student who has read every mystery in the library.
- The student you see reading as they walk down the corridor or off on a bench reading during lunch or reading while watching TV.

You get the idea: A student for whom reading is an essential part of their life.

To nominate a student as a Remarkable Reader,

- Send her/his name to the library with a brief description of why she/he is a remarkable reader.
- The library does the rest!
 - We put their name and picture up on our Remarkable Reader Board in the library.
 - We give the student a certificate naming them a Remarkable Reader.
 - With the parent's permission, we send their picture to the public library for a display honoring teen readers.
